FOR PALESTINIAN STUDENTS
IN INDONESIA
(SHORT COURSE PROGRAM)



Background

As one of the largest Islamic organization in Indonesia, Muhammadiyah has particular concern on education. Since its establishment, Muhammadiyah is consistent in developing schools, universities, and research centers. Currently, Muhammadiyah has 165 universities spreading all over Indonesia with various faculties and majors. Furthermore, Muhammadiyah facilitates both cadres and Indonesian citizens in general to have an equal access to education. At this moment, Muhammadiyah opens opportunities for global enthusiasts to join in Muhammadiyah-based education system.

Muhammadiyah is actively supporting students, teachers, lecturers, teaching staffs and citizens with various backgrounds to continue their study with scholarship from various providers. Muhammadiyah aims to cover more students with diverse identity backgrounds to get the opportunity and experience the education system in Indonesia. Not only Indonesian students, Muhammadiyah and 'Aisyiyah universities also accept and have foreign students from various countries around the world.

One of the countries that Muhammadiyah pays attention to is students from Palestine, a country that has suffered for decades from the colonialization of the Zionists Israel. This unrelenting conflict causes them having very limited access to education since they are experiencing difficult economic conditions. In response to this condition, Muhammadiyah offers scholarships to Palestinian students to continue their master's studies at Muhammadiyah universities in Indonesia, which include Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta, Universitas Muhammadiyah Surakarta, Universitas Ahmad Dahlan, Universitas 'Aisyiyah Yogyakarta, Universitas Muhammadiyah Makassar, Universitas Muhammadiyah Malang and Universitas Muhammadiyah Prof. DR. HAMKA. In addition to that, Muhammadiyah also offers scholarships for Short Course programs or summer programs for approximately one month. These short courses are intended to provide opportunities for Palestinians to learn from Indonesian Muslims.



Program Objectives

- To offer short course programs to share experiences, best practices in managing civil society and Muhammadiyah humanitarian programs to Palestinian people
- To facilitate Palestinians who are experiencing problems both economic and social, to gain more knowledge and experience in various fields
- To contribute to the human resource development, promote deeper cultural understanding and strengthen the relationship for both countries

Eligibility Criteria

- The applicant must be Palestinian
- Proficient in English Language
- The applicant must be a representative of any institution or organization
- Have a commitment to focus only on the program
- Possess minimum a bachelor degree
- Able to complete the online application form and provide all the required documents

Required Documents

1. Proof of citizenship (Official Passport and Personal ID)
2. Academic Certificate and Academic Transcripts (officially translated in English)
3. TOEFL/IELTS Certificate with at least the IBT TOEFL score of 80, or IELTS score of 6.0, or TOEIC score of 700 (must be obtained within last 2 years)*
4. Recommendation letter from the leader of institution or organization
5. Recommendation letter from prominent figure
6. Health Certificate
7. Statement of Purpose
8. Completed online application form

*Exemption: The applicant doesn't need to submit English test result if he/she is a graduate of universities in English-speaking countries



Application and Selection Process

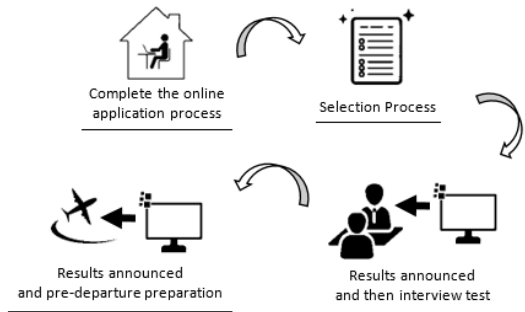
Application Procedures:

1. Complete the online application process;

2. Follow Selection process;

3. The selection results will be broadcasted online through the Muhammadiyah Scholarship website;

4. Applicants who pass the selection will then continue to do interview test online;



5. The test results will be announced online through the website and then pre-departure preparation will be informed.


During the application process, please pay close attention to some important information below:


1. We strongly suggest that you gather as much information as possible about the universities and your desired program. Be advised that once you are admitted, changing either university or program is strictly prohibited
2. **All required documents** must be written or officially **translated in English**
