Cost

The tuition fee is waived for students coming from abroad and partner universities.

Accommodation and food are at the students' own expense.

Due to limited on-campus accommodation, international students are offered fully-furnished off-campus accommodation that costs between Rp.500.000,-Rp.800.000,- per month including utilities charges. The estimated monthly expenses for an International student living in Yogyakarta is from Rp.1.000.000,- to Rp.1.500. 000 (approximately US \$.100-150,-/month. This includes, meals, utilities, local transportation and entertainment. Cost may vary depending on individual lifestyle
