- ✓ All applicants must demonstrate that they have good health and good character, sufficient for safe and effective practice as a midwife.
- ✓ Hold first degree of Bachelor of Midwifery.
- ✓ Applicant must be registered as a midwives (RM) in their home country and have to attach the proof of RM.
