RECTOR'S WELCOME

IKIP Muhammadiyah Maumere is a multicultural Muhammadiyah university located in Sikka Regency, Flores Island, East Nusa Tenggara. IKIP Muhammadiyah Maumere has reached the age of 10 years since its establishment on January 22, 2013 and has eight (eight) education study programs accredited B by BAN-PT and Excellent by LAM-DIK.



It also has Human Resources (HR) teaching staff 100% qualified with master's education. Currently, IKIP Muhammadiyah Maumere is developing into a multicultural and superior campus based on local wisdom in Sikka Regency and transforming into Muhammadiyah Maumere University.

The transformation into Universitas Muhammadiyah Maumere was carried out with the proposed addition of three study programs, namely, Health Administration, Informatics, and Digital Business. This change of form is expected to improve the positive image of IKIP Muhammadiyah Maumere in the community. In addition, the addition of new study programs can be a new attraction for IKIP Muhammadiyah Maumere.

Sikka Regency is one of the regions in East Nusa Tenggara that has diversity in terms of religion, ethnicity, and race. IKIP MUHAMMADIYAH MAUMERE

Muhammadiyah Higher Education (PTM) in Maumere began with the establishment of the University of Muhammadiyah Kupang (UMK) Maumere campus on the MoU of the Regent of SIKKA Drs. Paulus Moa with the rector of UMK H. Markhotib, SH, in 2002, and as the executor of PDM Sikka formed the management of UMK Maumere Campus, chaired by Drs. Ahmad Fadhlan, MH, and secretary Drs. M. Daeng Bakir. In its journey until the last batch of 2009, it has graduated approximately 1000 undergraduate graduates with Study programs in Indonesian Language Education, Biology Education, Management Economics, Accounting Economics, Sociology, Islamic education, and Law.

As a continuation of the UMK Maumere Campus, the idea of establishing an independent PTM was born, with a view to independence, university management, and the desire of the community for the presence of a PTM in Sikka Regency, so in 2009 a Committee for the Establishment of IKIP Muhammadiyah Maumere was formed, chaired by H. Jafar Umar, M.Sc., Ph.D., and Secretary H. Sudirman Badu, M.Pd., both of whom are permanent lecturers at Nusa Cendana University (UNDANA) and Muhammadiyah Kupang University (UMK). After the death of H. Jafar Umar, M.Sc., Ph.D. (rahimakumullah) in 2010, the position of chairman of the establishment committee was replaced by Erwin Prasetyo, ST.

Alhamdulillah, after a long and tiring journey by all parties, including the person in charge, Abdul Rasyid Wahab, BA, Chairman of the Muhammadiyah Regional Leadership of Sikka Regency, on January 22, 2013, the Operational Permit of the Institute of Teacher Training and Education (IKIP) Muhammadiyah Maumere, or abbreviated as IKIPMu Maumere, was issued with eight study programs, namely Mathematics Education, Physics Education, Chemistry Education, Biology Education, Indonesian Language Education, English Education, Economics Education, and Citizenship Education, through the Decree of the



Minister of National Education No. 21/E/O/2013 dated January 21/E/O/2013 dated January 22, 2013. Furthermore, on June 15, 2013, IKIPMu Maumere was inaugurated by the Reform figure Prof. Dr. H. Amien Rais, M.A., and attended by the Director General Of

Higher Education, Prof. Djoko Santoso, and the Secretary of KOPERTIS Region VIII, so that January 22 was designated as the anniversary or Milad of IKIP Muhammadiyah Maumere.

IKIP Muhammadiyah Maumere currently has two faculties, namely the Faculty of Social Science and Humanities Education (FPISHUM) and the Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences Education (FPMIPA), with eight study programs. All eight study programs have been accredited. Four study programs, namely Indonesian Language and Literature Education, Citizenship Education, Biology Education, and Mathematics Education, were accredited in 2014. while the other four Study programs were only accredited in 2017 and 2018. In 2019, IKIP Muhammadiyah Maumere was accredited, and in 2020, thank God, 4 study programs (Indonesian Language and Literature Education, Citizenship Education, Biology Education, and Mathematics Education) that carried out re-accreditation finally obtained very encouraging results, namely from C accreditation to B accreditation. Another accreditation achievement was achieved in 2023, when four study programs (English Education, Economics Education, Chemistry Education, and Physics Education) received the title of Excellent.

In the journey of IKIPMu Maumere until now, it has experienced a change of leadership, namely H. Rodja Abdul Natsir, SH, M.Pd, who was entrusted by the Muhammadiyah Central Leadership as Rector for two periods, namely from 2013–2017 and from 2017–2021. And the next Rector was entrusted by the Muhammadiyah Central Leadership to Erwin Prasetyo, S.T., M.Pd., from 2021 until now. Currently, the IKIPMu Maumere Campus occupies waqf land from H. Abdul Syukur covering an area of 8000 m2 out of a total waqf land of 9,894 m2 and land owned by IKIPMu Maumere covering an area of 372 m2. On this land, IKIPMu Maumere has lecture buildings, laboratories, offices, and other infrastructure. The Amien Rais building is 1,326 m2, the Ahmad Dahlan building is 1,176 m2, and the Dzasman Alkindi building is in the process of construction and covers an area of 4,000 m2.






