COURSE DESCRIPTION

Non-communicable disease is the highest cause of death in the world, including in Indonesia. Even 70% of the world's population reportedly died from this disease. Some of the most predominant non-communicable diseases are cardiovascular disease (AMI, CHF, & stroke) and metabolic disease (diabetes mellitus). This disease develops in a long time and actually can be controlled. Based on several studies, one of the main causes of this disease is an unhealthy lifestyle such as: Poor diet, lack of activity, smoking, and stress. The World Health Organization (WHO) and the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Indonesia are committed to reducing the incidence of NCDs with comprehensive promotion and preventive efforts. This course is one of the efforts to raise students' knowledge and awareness that overcoming this disease is quite important. The purpose of this course is to introduce students to how NCDs are developing in Indonesia & surrounding countries. COURSE DESCRIPTION

Indonesia has 17,000 islands from Sabang to Merauke (the western and eastern limits of Indonesia). The landscape of Indonesia also varies from highlands, volcanic mountains, to lowlands such as the coast. This encourages the Indonesian government to work harder to equalize the welfare of its people. Therefore, the Indonesian government initiated the establishment of BUMDes (Badan Usaha Milik Desa) or Village Owned Enterprises as one of the business units managed by the village government with the aim of increasing the village's economic welfare independently.

This course will discuss BUMDes and their role in supporting the development of MSMEs in Indonesia by utilizing the natural potential around them. The village as the smallest unit in a state institution that can reach individuals directly so that it has an important role in supporting the economic welfare of individual citizens. The existence of BUMDes supports the Indonesian people to develop their businesses both individually and in groups in the form of MSMEs.
